## **REPORTING ELECTIONEERING COMMUNICATIONS**

Reference: Section 2(7) and Section 6(1), article XXVIII of the Colorado Constitution; CPF Rule 11

You must identify spending on "electioneering communications" in your TRACER disclosure report if you spend \$1,000 or more in the calendar year on these communications and they are **broadcasted, printed, mailed, delivered, or distributed**.

What is an electioneering communication?

1) Any communication that is:

- Broadcasted by television or radio
- Printed in a newspaper or on a billboard
- Directly mailed
- Delivered by hand to personal residences
- Or otherwise distributed

AND

2) Refers to a candidate(s) (no ballot issues or ballot questions)

AND

3) Is broadcasted, printed, mailed, delivered, or distributed within thirty (30) days before a primary election or sixty days (60) before a general election
